2 Types of firings pottery pieces go through •1 Bisque Fire-Unglazed pottery is fired to a temperature that will make the clay strong but porous Porosity is necessary for the clay to accept the glaze During this firing the clay will shrink in size, the percentage that the clay shrinks is called the shrinkage rate •2
