Codes are listed in alphabetical order from A to Z, followed by number codes The information below ONLY pertains to identifying makers Note that headstamps often contain multiple pieces of information The maker is almost always identified Military ammunition usually includes date information, and civilian ammunition often has caliber

U.S. M1903 Springfield Rifle, Caliber .30-06

US M1903 Springfield Rifle, Caliber 30-06 Bolt action, magazine-fed, 5 round clip-loaded rifle adopted by the US Army as its primary shoulder arm in 1903 Replaced the M1892 30-40 caliber "Krag-Jorgensen" Rifle after a decade of service The rifle was patterned on the Mauser action of German manufacture Originally
